

The California Boating Safety Course Workshop



Come join us for 3 nights as we prepare to complete the California Boating Safety Course. Various local experts such as Captain Kirk Miller – sailing; John Lowry, Port San Luis Harbor patrol – safety; Kirk Petrie, Captain Cal Fire Avila Beach #62 - Personal Water Craft; Greg Robinson, Davis Boats – boat maintenance, and others will present course material covering State and Federal boating laws, rules of the road, boat handling, required equipment, navigational aids, accident reporting, and special topics. At the last session participants will have the opportunity to complete an open book, 50 question exam, which will then be mailed to the Department for processing. Those who successfully complete the course are awarded Certificates of Completion, which are recognized by many insurance companies for discounts on boat insurance policies.
