

## **SLYC Cruising Captain Procedures**

Develops and promotes cruising activities

Assists Power Captain in promoting boating safety education

Submits articles to Foghorn and Website

As examples, scheduled activities from 2008:

1. Mar 27-30 Santa Cruz Island
2. April 18 – 20 Jack London Square Boat Show (cancelled due to conflict with opening day at SLYC)
3. April 26-27 Elkhorn Slough kayaking
4. May 17, 18 Nacimiento Weekend
5. May 23, 24 Santa Cruz Island
6. July 12 Santa Barbara Harbor Rendezvous – good event for those without ability to cruise to get out on the water
7. July 20 Margarita Lake
8. July 25-27 Huntington Lake
9. August 17 Margarita Lake
10. August 22-24 Catalina or Santa Cruz Is
11. Sept 12-14 Santa Cruz Is (possibly Catalina if Aug. trip didn't work out)
12. Sept 21 Margarita Lake

The Cruising Captain (CC) schedules the above activities, but is not expected to be able to participate in all the activities. It's best to get dates on the calendar early in the year (say February), after checking SLYC events to avoid major conflicts (e.g., opening day, general meeting). The CC should ensure the scheduled events are on the website and in the Foghorn calendars and articles. The CC should ask (via email reminders, articles in Foghorn, etc.) those who are interested in any event to contact the CC, who can then in turn provide the connections for those who are planning to participate. If there is a change in the calendar, the CC should notify the membership via email - and, if there is enough lead-time, the Foghorn,
